Item No. 1 12th August, 2014	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>M.A.No. 401/2014</u></p> <p>The Learned Counsel for the BMC has filed an application for taking compliance on record through M.A.No. 401/2014. Copy of the same has been furnished to the Learned Counsel for the Applicant.</p> <p>The same is ordered to be taken on record. The M.A. stands disposed of.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>O.A.No. 34/2013</u></p> <p>We find that after the order dated 07.08.2014, manual cleaning operations were being carried out along the Shahpura Lake particularly along the side of Panchsheel Nallah with regard to the solid waste being generated in the nearby slums. It has been stated that about 7 truckloads of solid waste has been removed by using excavator. Similarly 2 truckloads were removed by using JCB and a team of about 28 labourers was also employed for the aforesaid purpose and one truckload of solid waste was also removed manually. It has been submitted on behalf of BMC that regular manual cleaning along the lake and nallah flowing into the Shahpura lake shall be carried out.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Shri Sachin K.Verma, Standing Counsel for the State as well as the</p>

Counsel for the BCM submitted that the UADD received the report submitted by the Consultant which has been sent by the BMC after due approval and the meeting of representatives of BMC, MPPCB and officials from the Government for consideration of the report will be convened within 10 days and a presentation regarding the same shall be given by the Consultant. It was submitted by Shri Verma that the outcome and the decision taken pursuant to the aforesaid presentation following the meeting shall be submitted before the Tribunal. It was brought to our notice that the comments made by the external Consultant ICF-GHK appointed for a safe review and giving the technical feasibility assessment on the report, which were filed alongwith the M.A.No, 389/2014 by the UADD, shall also be taken note of during the meeting and even the members of ICF-GHK shall be present at the time of the presentation for clarification of points noted by them in their mail sent on 25.07.2014.

The respondents shall file their response to the outcome of the meeting and the presentation and deliberations and the decision taken thereon by 15.09.2014. The copy of the compliance report in terms of our above directions be also given to the Learned Counsel for the Applicant on or before 15.09.2014.

In view of the above, the matter be listed on **18th September, 2014**.
