Item No. 5 18 th September, 2014	<p><u>M.A.No. 542/2014</u></p> <p>Shri Sachin K.Verma, Learned Counsel has moved this application seeking extension of time for compliance of our order dated 12.08.2014. We are afraid that we cannot accept the aforesaid application. This matter was filed before this Tribunal in June 2013 and from 2nd July, 2013, after the notices were issued, the Respondents have been putting in their appearance since the last one year and issues have been discussed threadbare as to what is the requirement with regard to the problem being faced in respect of improving the water quality in the Shahpura Lake as also preventing any flow of domestic solid and sewage waste into the Shahpura Lake through various nallahs which enter the said lake. Short term measures were carried out by the Municipal Authorities however, the problem still subsists. Manual cleaning operations along the nallahs is reportedly being carried out but it is far from satisfactory as</p>

domestic waste is being continuously thrown into the nallahs entering the lake from the adjoining colonies. Preventive action which should have been taken by now has not been taken as also long term plans in this behalf based upon the reports of the Consultant are yet to commence.

Accordingly, we would direct that, since the aforesaid task has to be carried out by the Bhopal Municipal Corporation with the assistance of the State Government; the Commissioner, Bhopal Municipal Corporation as well as the Secretary, Urban Administration and Development Department, GoMP shall file their affidavits giving stage-wise action plan with dates for commissioning and completion of each of the steps that are required to be taken in this behalf in accordance with the report of the Consultant which has already been considered and has been received by the BMC and the meeting with regard to the same has already taken place and the report was also sent to UADD.

The affidavits on the above issues with timeframe shall be filed by tomorrow. Accordingly, the prayer made in M.A.No. 542/2014 is not allowed and stands dismissed.
