<b>Item No. 7</b> <b>19<sup>th</sup> September, 2014</b>	<p>In terms of our order dtd. 18.09.2014 affidavit on behalf of Shri Tejaswi Nayak, Commissioner, Bhopal Municipal Corporation, Bhopal as well as Shri S.N. Mishra, Principal Secretary, Urban Development &amp; Environment have been filed along with the action plan indicating the phases under which the work will be undertaken by the Bhopal Municipal Corporation in respect of the issues pertaining to removing the pollution in the Shahpura lake Bhopal city. As far as works under Phase-I are concerned the same are likely to be completed by April, 2016 though most of the works are scheduled to be completed by May, 2015. It was submitted by Shri Vivek Agarwal, &amp; Shri Asad Ullah Khan Learned Counsels appearing on behalf of the Bhopal Municipal Corporation, and Shri Saluja, City Er. Bhopal City that necessary financial provision amounting to Rs. 12 Crores plus is available with the BMC for completion of the phase-I. So far as Phase-II works which mostly involve conservation and management proposals, the same are scheduled to be completed by July, 2016.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Shri Sachin K. Verma, Learned Counsel appearing for the State Government submitted that as far as Phase-II works are concerned necessary assistance and financial allocations by the State Government shall be provided under the budget for 2015-2016 and in case any assistance is required earlier the same shall also be considered.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">It has also been suggested that a view to oversee and monitor the</p>

progress of the works under Phase I & II a monitoring committee consisting three prominent citizens of Bhopal city, namely Shri K.S. Sharma, Rtd. Chief Secretary, Shri R.C. Chandel, Rtd. District Judge and Shri Hingorani, Chief Engineer (Rtd.) of Public Health Engineering Department may be constituted.

The Learned Counsel for the parties are directed to approach the aforesaid persons and obtain their consents for the aforesaid task after apprising them of our above order and file the letters of consents before this Tribunal. In the event of any of the aforesaid persons are not being available, Learned Counsel for the parties shall submit alternate names by way of replacement to the aforesaid names preferably from the same background.

Having heard the Learned Counsel for the parties and considering the aforesaid affidavits we are of the opinion as was submitted before us by the Learned Counsel for the Applicant & Respondents that the matter can be disposed of with necessary directions in terms of the action plan and affidavits submitted.

Accordingly, Original Application No. 34/2013 stands disposed of. See separate judgement.
