<p>Item No. 7 24th August, 2015.</p>	<p>Today the matter was taken up with regard to the issue raised by the Applicant for the accumulation of solid waste at the entry point of the <i>nallas</i> mainly from the Ekant Park and Manisha Market site into the Shahpura Lake. Today the officers from the Municipal Corporation have submitted that efforts are going on for removal of the material from the aforesaid point. He further submitted that the filtration bunds that were constructed in the <i>nallas</i> in the Ekant Park, due to heavy rain have suffered considerably damage and are not working so far as today efforts are going on to repair the same. We direct that the aforesaid work be completed departmentally and the same be made operational within two weeks. The PCB shall also inspect the ongoing work and suggest any technical support that may be required for the same.</p> <p>During the course of hearing it was also suggested that the fountains which have been put into place in Shahpura Lake are at present located for the purpose of aeration in somewhat middle of the lake and the need is for taking them closer to the entry point of the Ekant Park nalla and the Manisha Market nalla where mostly polluted water from these drains is entering into the Shapura Lake. The representatives from the BMC submitted that in consultation with the R.O., MPPCB office they will take up the aforesaid issue and on the experimental basis shift the fountain closer to the entry point of the two <i>nallas</i> which are flowing into the Shahpura Lake. This exercise be commenced within two weeks from today and all</p>

necessary steps that may be required shall also be simultaneously taken into account.

Let the matter be listed on **11th September, 2015.**
