<b>Item No. 6,7,8 &amp;9 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2015</b>	We have heard the Learned Counsel for the Applicant as well as the Learned Counsel for the Respondent. Today, the issue with regard to the new landfill site of the Bhopal Municipal Corporation at Adampur was discussed. It has been pointed out that so far no progress has been made either in the

development of the site at Adampur and even for obtaining the EC for the same in accordance with the EIA notification as it was submitted that the same will be probably fall within the B-category project in the EIA notification of 2006. While initially it was submitted that the EC was required to be obtained by the contractor to whom the contract for waste disposal is likely to be given in terms of the DPR that has been prepared in terms of the proposed waste to energy and other such technologies i.e. to be deployed for the management of the waste. We are of the opinion that so far as the obtaining of the EC is concerned, the BMC or the Department of Urban Development, Govt. of MP should apply for the said EC as enough time has been devoted to finalisation of the site and for making the same available for the purpose of municipal solid waste.

The Learned Counsel for the State as well as the Learned Counsel for the BMC submitted that they would take steps for moving the application before the SEIAA for obtaining the EC for the Adampur landfill site at Bhopal. Learned Counsel for the State submitted that one month's time may be allowed to submit the application after looking into the entire pros and cons in this behalf.

Let the matter be listed after one month i.e. on **21<sup>st</sup> September, 2015**. The Respondents shall report the progress in the matter after one month.
