Date and Remarks	Orders of the Tribunal
Item No. 3 3rd March, 2015	<p>Pursuant to the notice issued vide order dated 13.01.2015, both the industries i.e. M/s S.D.Bansal Iron and Steel Ltd. and M/s Sonic Biochem Extractions at Mandideep, have put in their appearance through Shri Ayush Dev Bajpai, Learned Counsel and Shri Ajay Gupta, Learned Counsel respectively. Shri Ayush Dev Bajpai has submitted the reply to the show-cause notice. The same is ordered to be taken on record.</p> <p>As regards the reply submitted on behalf of M/s S.D.Bansal at Mandideep which is submitted by Shri Ayush Dev Bajpai on their behalf that the task of installation of bag-filters is almost complete and only the covering is required to be carried out. He prays that four weeks time may be granted to carry out the aforesaid task. As soon as the aforesaid task is completed, the management of M/s S.D.Bansal Iron and Steel Ltd. shall convey the said information to the officials of the MPPCB who shall thereafter carry out an inspection of the same and submit the report before the Tribunal.</p> <p>On behalf of M/s Sonic Biochem industry Shri Ajay Gupta, Learned Counsel submits that with a view to contain and reduce the emissions, the</p>

industry has started to use rice husk as fuel reducing the requirement of coal and accordingly reducing the emissions as well. However, he submits that all necessary measures are being taken care of and the industry is in the process of placing orders for the necessary equipment to be installed. He submits that the industry will take steps expeditiously for placing the orders as they are in the process of finalising the said issue. Shri Ajay Gupta, Learned Counsel shall inform this Tribunal the steps taken by M/s Sonic Biochem on the next date and in case we are not satisfied with the steps taken so far, this tribunal will not hesitate in passing appropriate orders against the defaulting industry.

Learned Counsel appearing for the Municipal Council, Mandideep submits that the Government only yesterday has given financial sanction for the establishment of STP and landfill site at Mandideep for which now the Municipal Council, Mandideep will take steps for inviting tenders, etc. The progress made in this behalf shall be reported before the Tribunal on the next date.

The Learned Counsel for the State submits that on the issue with regard to the ban on manufacture, sale, distribution and use of poly-carry bags, the matter is coming before the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 19.03.2015 and a similar issue which is being dealt with by this Tribunal on the compliance front is in the case of Sandeep Lahariya V/s State of MP & Ors (O.A.No. 04/2013) which is fixed for hearing on 26.03.2015. As such the matter may be listed on **26th March, 2015.**
