Item No. 3 13th July, 2015	<p>Learned Counsel for Respondent No. 7 / Municipal Board has filed compliance report along with documents to show that the NIT for construction, installation and commissioning of the STP at Mandideep have been invited. It has further been submitted that after the publication, bids have been received and contract awarded on 07.07.2015.</p> <p>The matter has been examined by the Technical Appraisal Committee and is awaiting the approval of the State Government. Learned Counsel submits that in a period of about two weeks, the approval is expected and as soon as the approval is received, they will be able to start the work after awarding the work order.</p> <p>Learned Counsel for the State and the MPPCB as well as the Municipal Board, Mandideep submitted that the programme for carrying out the plantation will be worked out after taking into consideration the views expressed by the Forest Department in that behalf with regard to the nature of species to be planted and their availability. They submit that a meeting of the concerned</p>

departments and officials will be called for this purpose to carry out the aforesaid programme in accordance with the views expressed in the order dated 07.05.2015. Learned Counsel submits that the aforesaid meeting will be convened within a week and steps taken to proceed in accordance with the decision taken therein keeping in view the directions dated 07.05.2015. It has further been submitted that M/s Sonic Biochem Industries was granted 12 weeks time for carrying out the necessary measures. In the meanwhile, they have furnished solvent security to the tune of Rs. 25 lakhs before the Regional Officer, MPPCB.

Let the matter be listed after four weeks. Put up on **18th August, 2015.**
