Ltd, Mandideep wherein it has been submitted that the industry has successfully installed the bag filter and the same is running on trial. The stack monitoring has already been carried out and the air monitoring as per the Annexure R-2 are also satisfactory and is within the prescribed limit.</p> <p>In view of the above, the security deposit which was made by the industry is ordered to be released.
