<b>Date and Remarks</b>	<b>Orders of the Tribunal</b>
<b>Item No. 1</b> <b>27<sup>th</sup> July, 2015</b>	<p>Learned Counsel for the State as well as the Municipal Board, Mandideep submitted that while 11 acres of land in Mandideep had been allotted by the Collector, Raisen, the allotment has been stayed by the Additional Divisional Commissioner, Bhopal on an appeal filed on the ground that allegedly 4.363 hectares of allotted land forms part of <i>shamshan (marghat)</i> and therefore, could not be allotted.</p> <p>After hearing the matter, it was brought to our notice that the Learned Additional Divisional Commissioner has stayed the allotment order. Learned Counsel for the State submitted that the State has got 40 acres of land in Mandideep which is capable of being allotted and the Collector would examine the possibility of allotting contiguous land equivalent to the area of land of the <i>marghat (shamshan)</i> so that the required 11 acres of land for setting up the Municipal Solid Waste site can be prepared. All other options shall also be looked into and they would be examined whether a fresh order can be issued before the next date of hearing by the Additional Divisional Commissioner.</p> <p>We would direct that the Collector shall depute a responsible</p>

Officer with the relevant revenue records of the area comprising 40 hectares which is available in Mandideep so that contiguous land which is not disputed can be allotted so as to make the available site of 11 acres.

The Learned Counsel and Officer Incharge from the Municipal Board, Mandideep submitted that so far financial sanctions for the STP have not been received from the Government. Shri Sachin K.Verma, Learned Counsel will look into the aforesaid issue after getting the necessary information from the Government and provide the same on the next date of hearing and apprise the officers to expedite the matter as enough time has been granted.

Dr. Subhash C.Pandey, Applicant also submitted that the development plan of the area has also not been placed on record. Shri Sachin K.Verma will also make submissions with regard to the same and place the same before the Tribunal on the next date.
